I might as well try to tell the members of this society which variety taste as good with the price at fifteen cents as when a dollar per bushel. In potato growing the most essential are good seed and good, clean, mellow soil. The seed should be selected in harvesting the crop and stored not in a cellar under a dwelling house, but in a cave such as is used in wintering nursery stock, or else select a high well drained piece of ground, dig a trench about four feet wide, four feet deep and the required length, according to the quantity of seed wanted, fill to the depth of three feet with potatoes, lay old fence post or anything...
