

Excerpt from Circular of Information Relative to the Certificate Laws of Oregon Inasmuch as an attempt is being made to change the certificate laws of Oregon, so that graduates of colleges will be authorized to teach in the elementary schools without having had special training for such work, and also to require the University of Oregon and Oregon Agricultural College to train teachers for elementary work, this circular is issued to give to members of the legislature and to school officers, definite information on this subject. In November, 1910, the United States Bureau of Education called a conference of college presidents, normal school presidents and state school superintendents to consider the matter of adopting some uniform standards for teachers certificates. A body of resolutions defining such standards were adopted. The Oregon legislature met the following January (1911), and enacted a certificate law based upon these resolutions. The bill was most carefully considered by the committees on education from the Senate and the House, which met in joint session and summoned before them the college presidents and other...
